

Eastman Summer Intensive 2017

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The working language during the Eastman Summer Intensive is English.

Someone is regarded as **Eastman Summer Intensive** participant only after she/he has paid the necessary fees and has received a final confirmation from Eastman.

Eastman has the right to substitute teachers.

CLASS ATTENDANCE & LEVEL

If the level of the class or workshop is not adequate for the participant, the teacher can, in consult with the coordinator, change him/her to a class or workshop of another level.

Participants are expected to attend all their classes and activities within their schedule. Dancers arriving late for a class or workshop can be refused entry to the studio.

It is requested that nobody interrupts classes. The classes have to be taken entirely. If a participant gets injured, he/she can attend classes and workshops as an observer.

It is prohibited for participants to make video recordings and/or photographs of repertory pieces, dancers and teachers during the course.

PRESENCE IN CLASS

Participants announce possible absences in advance to the teachers and the **Eastman Summer Intensive** coordinator before the start of the class or workshop.

SAFETY

Only the dance studios and the "*artiesten foyer*" are accessible for participants. All the other facilities are closed for the participants.

Participants are thoroughly advised not to leave any valuable personal belongings in the dressing rooms. Eastman is not liable for damage and/or theft of personal belongings. Participants should take all valuable personal belongings into the studios and keep them close at all times.

The participant is aware that participation in the course, during classes or other activities organized by Eastman, can bring risks. Participation in the course is on a voluntary base and for the risk of the participant. Eastman does not accept any liability for any material or immaterial damage (injuries, matter damage and possible consequences of damage included), irrespective of its cause.

Eastman must be informed in advance by the participant about any injuries that incurred in the past and/or present. Failure to report medical issues, as well as other issues that concern a participant's well-being is at the risk of the participant; failure to report can lead to immediate expulsion of the course if necessary.

Participants are obliged to provide for their own health and liability insurances and provide proof if requested by Eastman. Without the proper insurance (including coverage of physical therapy) the participant cannot participate in the course.

Any medical problem that causes difficulties in dancing and hinder the active participation in classes, have to be communicated clearly to the teacher.
